### Notes

In 1902, Bloomsdale, Missouri, USA was a small rural town with a population of around 300 people. The town was primarily agricultural, with many residents working on farms or in local businesses. 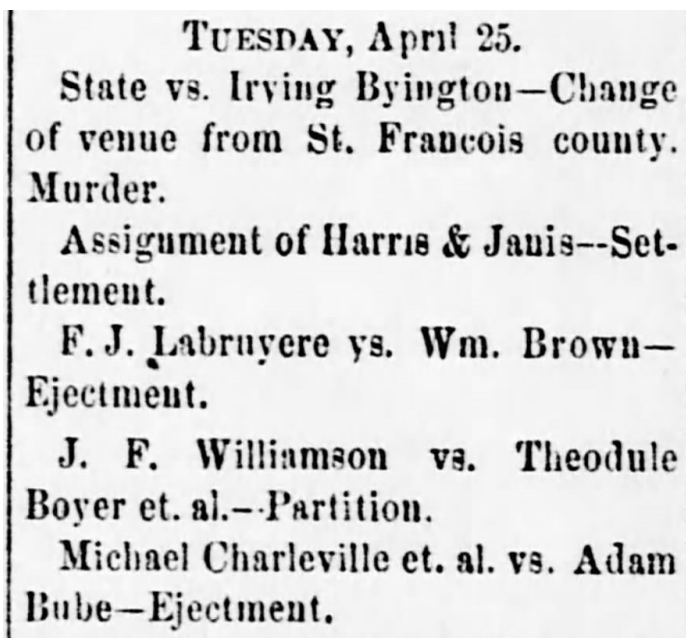

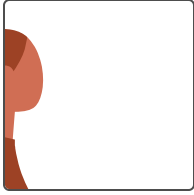
